Supplemental Educational Services

Information

Due to the Title I District Improvement Status for Middlebury Community Schools, some students are eligible for free tutoring. Student eligibility is based on the following:

- 1) Student must be attending York Elementary School.**
- 2) Student must be non-proficient in grade level school work. That means below grade level in reading, math, and writing as determined by district assessments.**
- 3) Student must qualify for free or reduced lunches.**

All of the above criteria must be present for the student to qualify for supplemental educational services. All students who meet the eligibility guidelines above have been notified by mail.

All tutoring is provided by state-approved companies that parents choose from a specific list. All tutoring must take place outside of the regular school day.

Middlebury Community Schools has a limited amount of funding to provide tutoring for students. The procedure for determining which students receive tutoring will be based on most critical need by grade level. That means that all third grade students will be considered first priority. After the third grade student requests are fulfilled, then second grade students with most critical need will be considered. All parents who request tutoring will be notified by the district if their child will be served or be on the waiting list for services.
