For children who have delayed immunizations, please refer to the 2010 CDC “Catch-up Immunization Schedule” to determine adequately immunizing doses. All minimum intervals and ages for each vaccination as specified per the 2010 CDC guidelines must be met for a dose to be valid. *Four doses of DTaP/DTP/DT are acceptable if 4th dose was administered on or after child’s fourth birthday.

**Three doses of polio vaccine are acceptable if 3rd dose was administered on or after child’s fourth birthday and the doses are all IPV or all OPV.

!The 4th dose of polio must be administered on or after child’s fourth birthday. This applies only to kindergarten for 2010-2011.

~Two doses alternative adolescent schedule (Recombivax HB given at age 11-15 years x 2 doses) is acceptable if properly documented.

^Physician documentation of disease history, including month and year, is proof of immunity for preschool, kindergarten, and 1st grade students. A signed statement from the parent/guardian indicating history of disease, including month and year, is required in grades 2-12.

Minimum Requirements for School Entry 2010-2011

Grades 2-5

- 5 doses of diphtheria-tetanus-acellular pertussis (DTap), diphtheria-tetanus-pertussis (DTP), or pediatric diphtheria-tetanus vaccine (DT) (4 doses are acceptable in the 4th dose was administered on or after the 4th birthday and at least 6 months after the 3rd dose).
- 4 doses of any combination of IPV or OPV by age 4-6 (3 doses of all OPV or all IPV are acceptable if the 3rd dose was administered on or after the 4th birthday).
- 3 doses of Hep B vaccine (3rd dose must be on or after 24 weeks of age).
- 2 doses of measles (rubeola) vaccine on or after the first birthday.
- 2 doses of mumps vaccine on or after the 1st birthday
- 1 dose of rubella (German measles) vaccine on or after the first birthday.
- 1 dose of varicella (chickenpox) vaccine on or after the first birthday or written history of disease. A signed parental statement of history of chickenpox disease is acceptable proof of immunity.

Grades 6-12

- 5 doses of diphtheria-tetanus-acellular pertussis (DTap), diphtheria-tetanus-pertussis (DTP), or pediatric diphtheria-tetanus vaccine (DT) (4 doses are acceptable in the 4th dose was administered on or after the 4th birthday and at least 6 months after the 3rd dose).
- 4 doses of any combination of IPV or OPV by age 4-6 (3 doses of all OPV or all IPV are acceptable if the 3rd dose was administered on or after the 4th birthday).
- 3 doses of Hep B vaccine (3rd dose must be on or after 24 weeks of age).
- 2 doses of measles (rubeola) vaccine on or after the first birthday.
- 2 doses of mumps vaccine on or after the 1st birthday
- 1 dose of rubella (German measles) vaccine on or after the first birthday.
- 2 doses of varicella (chickenpox) vaccine on or after the first birthday or written history of disease. A signed parental statement of history of chickenpox disease is acceptable proof of immunity.
- 1 dose of tetanus-diphtheria-acellular pertussis vaccine (Tdap) given on or after 10 years of age
- 1 dose of meningococcal conjugate vaccine (MCV4)

Additional Elkhart County Health Department Clinic Hours Available for Immunizations

- Every Wednesday from June through September late appointments are available in Elkhart and Goshen.
- The fourth Wednesday of June, July, August and September, walk-ins may come in from 1-5pm.
- There is an additional walk-in on September 15th from 3-5pm. Additional nurses will be available to accommodate more students.
- Appointments are still available at all immunization sites during regular hours.
