If you are 18 or older, you may choose to receive either the single-dose Johnson & Johnson (Janssen) or the Pfizer vaccine, which requires a second dose to be fully protected. Individuals age 12-17 must receive the Pfizer vaccine. An adult must accompany children age 12-15 to the vaccine appointment. If the adult present is not the parent or guardian, consent must be submitted in advance. For anyone age 16-17 it's preferred that a parent or guardian accompany the minor to the vaccination site. We understand this may not always be possible. In those cases, the parent or guardian can provide written or verbal authorization.
