

## Student Driving and Parking Rules

1. Student's having a valid driver's license may drive to school and park in areas designated for students.
2. All student vehicles are to be parked in the northwest student lots.
3. Cars are to be locked at all times.
4. Students may not take cars, motorcycles, or other vehicles off school grounds during school hours without permission of a school official.
5. Students may not go to their car during school hours without permission of a faculty member.
6. Students are expected to drive with caution in the parking lot, observing the 15MPH speed limit.
7. Students must register their vehicles and purchase a parking tag before September 2<sup>nd</sup>. If a student earns their driver's license after the start of the school year, the student must register their vehicle(s) and purchase a parking tag prior to driving to school.
8. All students and teachers must have a permit and tag to park on school grounds.
9. When leaving the parking lot students must yield to buses.
10. Student drivers are subject to random drug testing. The student and his parent or guardian must sign and turn in the random drug testing agreement to receive a parking tag.

Students found in violation of the above regulations may have their driving privileges suspended in addition to other disciplinary measures.
